DEPARTURES:

Big Rapids – Meijer parking lot Pole H at 7:00 AM
Grand Rapids – Radisson Inn on Ann St Exit 88 & 131 at 8:00 AM

Depart Big Rapids at 7:00 AM followed by a pick-up stop in Grand Rapids. Enjoy juice and sweetrolls served enroute to Canada. We travel to Port Huron and cross into Canada on the Blue Water Bridge.

A lunch on your own is planned at **White Oaks Mall** food court in London, Ontario.

Upon arrival in Toronto we check in to the **Delta Chelsea** which is conveniently located in the heart of downtown Toronto, near the Eaton Centre. The Delta Chelsea provides a 100 % smoke-free environment.



After a brief city orientation tour on the motorcoach we enjoy dinner at the **Joe Badali's Ristorante Italiano** on Front Street.

After dinner we explore **The Distillery Historic District** – the centre for arts, culture, and entertainment with a rich architectural legacy. Arrive back to your hotel room in time for a good night's rest.

Day 2 May 30

Start the day with a **Breakfast buffet in the hotel.**

This morning we visit the newly renovated **Art Gallery of Ontario** (designed by world renowned architect Frank Gehry) and see **Picasso: Masterpieces from the Musee National Picasso, Paris.** This monumental exhibition represents works produced during every major artistic period of Pablo Picasso's eight-decade career. It includes 176 works from Picasso's personal collection- art that he kept for himself with the purpose of shaping his own legacy.

At 12:55 pm we board the motorcoach at the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO) and travel a short distance to **The Princess Wales Theatre.** We have reserved seats for the 1:30 pm musical **War Horse**, which is a new production in Toronto. Winner of 6 Tony Awards including BEST PLAY, this new play adapted from Michael Morpurgo's novel, is a remarkable tale of courage, loyalty and friendship. *'An extraordinary piece of theatre that is at once both epic and intimate, absolutely guaranteed to move the heart.'* Sunday Express of London

The remainder of the day is yours to plan as you wish— perhaps shopping Eaton Centre - Toronto's largest indoor shopping center with over 350 shops or take a stroll on Yonge Street- the longest street in the world. Or perhaps go back to the AGO with your ticket and visit the museum's permanent collection until closing at 8:30 PM.

Day 3 May 31

After a Breakfast buffet in the hotel, we depart Toronto around 9 AM.

A short distance north of our hotel we visit Toronto's majestic castle, **Casa Loma.** During the self-guided audio tour you can visit decorated suites, towers, foot tunnel, stables, and the floral filled 5-acre estate gardens.

Approx. 1:15 pm we stop for a delicious **Lunch buffet at Elm Hurst Inn** Ingersoll, Ontario, Can.

We return to Michigan after stopping at the **Canadian duty-free shop** in Sarnia before entering the U.S. Around 5 PM we have scheduled a fast food stop on your own in Davison. We return to Grand Rapids approximately 8:30 PM & Big Rapids 9:30 PM.
